## DISABILITY EMPLOYMENT SERVICES (DES)

If you have a disability, injury or illness, Disability Employment Service (DES) providers may be able to support you to get job ready and find open employment. If you have a job, they can also support with maintaining your job or additional training.

If you're looking for work, a DES provider can help you:

- get ready to work
- train in specific job skills
- write your resumé
- train in interview skills
- look for jobs that suit you

Once your DES provider places you in a job, they can also help you with:

- on-the-job training
- communicating with your boss and co-workers
- ongoing support in your job
- modifying your workplace
- Auslan at work

Workforce Australia is the employment service delivered by the Department of Employment and Workplace Relations and has replaced Jobactive.

If you don't have a disability, injury or illness Workforce Australia may be able to offer employment support. Workforce Australia has a range of services available to help all Australians, not just people on income support, to find, keep, change jobs or create their own job.

Assistance could include:

- information and technical support
- assistance to manage mutual obligation requirements
- access to education, training and other supports
- help to get certain items to find and start a job, or to move for a new job
